Recruit Pledges | Current Commit20 participants

Recruit people to pledge at least 20 hours of community service at www.commit20.com/pledge. Encourage volunteers who were part of Commit20 in 2015 to log their 2016 volunteer service towards this year's contest!



Volunteer

Have your organization's volunteers complete service hours and log their hours with www.commit20.com/log-hours. On the pledge form, they will need to indicate your organization in the "How Did You Hear About Us" textbox.



Log Hours

Make sure your pledges log their completed volunteer hours at www.commit20.com/log-hours. This is very important, as this is the number that will be counted to determine the contest winner. Any service hours volunteers may have already served from January 2016 on are still eligible to be logged and counted for the contest. All volunteers may back log service hours through January 1, 2016 to be counted towards the contest.



Tracking

We will keep track of the total hours served by your volunteers when they indicate what organization they volunteered for on their hours log. The organization with the most hours logged by Sept. 15th, 2016 will win the grand prize!

Entry Period

To participate in the Commit to Recruit contest, all pledges and hours logged must be submitted by September 15, 2016. Sun Valley Landscaping will announce the contest winner by October 15, 2016.

Judging

To determine the winner, we will add up the total hours logged online at www.commit20.com/log-hours by each organization's pledge recruits. The organization with the most hours logged by pledge recruits will win the \$5,000 landscaping project. In the event of a tie, a Sun Valley Landscaping contest committee will review each organization and select the winner or designate a tie breaking challenge.

Prize

The \$5,000 retail-value landscape project will be awarded on Earth Day 2017, which is April 22, 2017. The grand prize is non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for monetary value.

Organization Eligibility

Only non-profits, volunteer organizations, 501(c) 3's, or foundations in the Omaha Metro area are eligible to win the grand prize. Exceptions to this rule will be at the discretion of the Sun Valley Landscaping contest committee. Contact us to see if your organization is eligible to win.

Volunteer Hour Eligibility

Any hours volunteered between January 2016 and September 15, 2016 that are unpaid work for a cause are eligible for Commit to Recruit contest. If your recruits are part of a service program that receives a form of compensation such as AmeriCorps contact us at giveback@commit20.com to learn about their specific hour eligibility.
